Inhalt	<p>The possible departure of the United Kingdom from the European Union (“Brexit”) is a threatening danger to the European economy. Especially startups profit from the characteristics of the Common Market and the economic development. As a result, the European Union has become a Startup Ecosystem depending on the free movement of goods, capital, services and labor.</p> <p>Different Brexit scenarios cause various consequences with significant effects on European startups. It is indeterminate how Brexit could affect startups especially in the United Kingdom.</p>
